



Instructions for posters

The full paper of your poster will also be published in the proceedings. It needs then to be uploaded (on your Personal home page, button "Upload full paper") before August 15, 2010.

Concerning the poster in itself, there is no need to upload it on the website. Please notice that you are responsible for printing it in advance and send it to the Palais des Congrès or bring it with you at the conference. It is not possible to print posters at the conference site.

You must display your poster (permanent session) as soon as you arrive. You will find your reserved place by referring to the number on your paper. Authors are asked to stand by their posters during the sessions allocated for this purpose, so that they can answer questions.

Each **poster board measures 96 cm wide by 250 cm high** (portrait format).

We propose the **A0 format** for your poster (84,1 cm × 118,9 cm). The boards are made of PVC, and we recommend using double-sided tape, available on site. Make sure your poster is not too heavy and avoid laminated plastic or cardboard-backed sheets, as you will not be allowed to use pins or drawing pins.

The title of your poster must appear at the top, in 25 mm-high capital letters. Make sure that the authors and their corresponding organisations are clearly visible.
